The Division for Learning Disabilities (DLD) of the Council for Exceptional Children invites applications for the editorship of Learning Disabilities Research & Practice (LDRP). The journal publishes original research and describes validated practices relating to learning disabilities. LDRP is highly regarded by both scholars and professional practitioners in good part because of the skills and leadership of its previous editors (Kenneth Kavale and Susan Vogel, Margo Mastropieri and Tom Scruggs, Deborah Speece and Sharon Vaughn; Addison Stone and Joanne Carlisle; Charles Hughes). LDRP is read by more than 10,000 individual subscribers and is in the periodical collections of several hundred university libraries. The editorship position may be filled by one or two people (in a co-editor arrangement). The editor(s) will begin working with the current editor as soon as possible to ensure a smooth transition. The specific duties and responsibilities of the editor(s) are:

1. To coordinate the process of reviewing manuscripts.
2. To communicate with authors about publication decisions.
3. To keep LDRP on a timely publication schedule.
4. To make final decisions concerning the selection of articles for each issue.
5. To work cooperatively with the DLD Board, its Publications Committee, and the publisher to develop and maintain a budget for the operation of the journal
6. To maintain and improve the quality of the journal.
