Position

Michigan State University announces a position at the Assistant Professor level for a candidate of exceptional promise with expertise in the area of Autism Spectrum Disorder. The position will be in the Department of Counseling, Educational Psychology, and Special Education.

The College of Education at Michigan State is widely recognized as a leading intellectual center for educational research and teacher education. Eight of its programs are ranked among the top nine nationally. The special education program offers degrees in learning disabilities and autism spectrum disorder (ASD) at the undergraduate, masters, and doctoral levels. It is expected that the faculty member will maintain an active research program and seek external funding to support that program, teach undergraduate, masters, and/or doctoral courses, and mentor doctoral students.

Qualifications

Applicants for this position must hold a PhD in special education or a related area. They should demonstrate evidence of a productive research program and the potential for national visibility as a scholar and leader. Prior experience and certification as a special education teacher in the area of emotional impairment or ASD is highly desirable.
